

S2324-R5: Resolution to Allocate Funding for a Multicultural Collaboration Grant

WHEREAS, there is a need to create funding opportunities for collaborative programs put on by the multicultural organizations of the Student Association; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 7 of the Student Association Corporate Bylaws states that the Vice President for Finance shall “have charge and custody of, and be responsible for, all funds and securities of the corporation”; and

WHEREAS, Policy VI, Section 14 of the Student Association Management Policies states that “once approved by Congress the budget cannot be amended without a majority vote of Congress with previous notice”; and

WHEREAS, Policy II, Section D, Subsection VI of the Student Association Management Policies states that the Vice President for Multicultural Affairs “Facilitates and promotes programming aimed at celebrating multiculturalism within the University community.”; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that a new account be created for the Vice President for Multicultural Affairs office with funding in the amount of \$2,000 solely for a multicultural collaboration programming grant for all Student Association Organizations.

IMPACT STATEMENT

This resolution calls for an amendment to the 2023-2024 budget to create an account and allocate funding in the amount of \$2,000 for the Vice President for Multicultural Affairs office. These funds are solely for a multicultural collaboration programming grant open to Student Association organizations.
