

Cherry Pineapple Dump Cake

Here's what you need:

- 1 box yellow cake mix, any brand, I use Betty Crocker
- 1 (21 oz. approx.) can cherry pie filling
- 1 (20 oz. approx.) crushed pineapple with juice
- 1-1/2 sticks butter, sliced into 1/4" pieces approx.
- 1 cup coconut, I use sweetened but unsweetened will be fine, optional

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.

Okay here is where the cake got its name....in a 9 x 13 "dump" the cherry pie filling and pineapple with juice and mix until incorporated.

After it's combined, sprinkle the cake mix evenly over the top of the filling and spread out with a fork.

When the cake mix is spread out evenly, slice the butter and cover the cake mix.

If using coconut, sprinkle 1 cup over the top of the butter and bake for 45 minutes to 1 hour. Mine took about 50 minutes.

Serves 12 - 16
