

Parent Job Requirements

Every member family of Minds in Action is required to contribute in some way to make our co-op a success. Unless completing a special job, each family is required to clean up once per semester and be hall monitor 3-4 times (depending on enrollment numbers and days in the semester). Exact requirements will be listed on the sign up for jobs.

Job Opt Out

Families unable to complete jobs can opt out by paying a fee. Another family will then be paid to do the job. Opt out fees will be determined after registration when we know how many member families we have and will be listed on the sign up for jobs. Fees are due the first day of class.

The sign up for jobs will be emailed out to member families prior to the start of first semester.

JOB DESCRIPTION SUMMARY:

Clean-Up

The family in charge of clean-up is responsible to make sure we leave the facility in as good or better condition as when we found it. Children and teens are encouraged to help with clean-up, but at least one parent is responsible to supervise and ensure the facility is clean.

- Clean up family is responsible to wipe tables and chairs, put tables and chairs back in the correct locations, take care of trash, empty trash, vacuum, sweep and take care of any other messes.
- Clean up takes place in the basement, lobby, stairs, classrooms, nursery and bathrooms.
