College/ University Admissions:

- High school classes, high school grades, and test scores matter.
- Admissions representatives will visit Hoggard - check Student Services website/ listen to announcements.
- **MILITARY ACADEMIES** - application process begins spring of 11th grade year.
- For most schools, the application process begins in August/September of senior year.

NCAA Eligibility

For Division 1 and Division 2 schools, apply during summer after junior year.

16 core classes required (10 prior to semester 7).

Minimum 2.3 GPA in core classes.
