Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Greetings of the Season (164325)
- Card Stock and Paper: Very Vanilla (101650);
 Mossy Meadow (133676); Graceful Greenery
 Vellum (164118); Season of Green & Gold
 Designer Series Paper (DSP) (164324))
- Stamp Pads: Mossy Meadow (147111)
- **Tools:** Greetings of the Season Dies (164112); Golden Greenery Dies (164116))
- Miscellaneous: Cherry Cobbler & Pearl Adhesive-Backed Berries (164119); Very Vanilla Satin Ribbon (164120); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813); Mini Glue Dot (103683); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)



Measurements:

- Very Vanilla: 4 ¼" x 11" scored @ 5 ½", 3" x 4" (tag)
- Mossy Meadow: 2 1/4" x 4 1/4"
- Graceful Greenery Vellum: 4" x 4"
- DSP:3 ¾" x 5"
 Ribbon:5 inches

Instructions:

- 1. Using the measurements, score and cut paper.
- 2. Die cut the large tag in Very Vanilla. Die cut the label in Mossy Meadow and cut it in half. Die cut the Vellum with the Golden Greenery Dies (or fussy cut 2 pine branches).
- **3.** Stamp onto the tag with Mossy Meadow the "May your season..." greeting on the lower half of the tag.
- 4. Glue the DSP to the cardbase. Attach to the back of the tag Dimensionals only on the center. Attach that to the DSP. Slide the Mossy Meadow until the tag on top and bottom. Use liquid glue to attach the Mossy Meadow. Use Glue Dots to attach the Vellum over the tag holes.
- **5.** Make a knot bow with the Satin Ribbon and pull at the ends to allow it to fray a little. Attach over the Vellum with a Glue Dot.
- **6.** Embellish with 3 Cherry Cobbler Berries on top of the Vellum.
