



Student Material Management

1. Place Letters A-Z in order on Magnetic Boards for everyday use.
(these letters always remain on the boards)
2. Organize additional Letter Magnets for easy access.
(i.e. drawer organizers, craft box organizers, magnetic grid, etc.)
3. Assemble sets of 6 white and 3 green sound circles for students.
(included with the manipulative kits)
4. Prepare Phoneme Segmentation and Phoneme-Grapheme work mats.
(pull from workbooks and put in sheet protectors)
5. Gather a set of markers, colored pencils, etc. for small groups.
(Remember S.P.I.R.E. groups should not exceed 6 students).
