Electrical Trades Inside Wireman is a highly in-demand career field with the potential for promotion within the industry. In this program, students will learn the ins and outs of the electrical field, from wiring an outlet to the distribution of power throughout commercial facilities. Students study AC and DC theory, bending conduit, electrical motor controls, use of hand tools, health and safety, and more. This two-year, state of Ohio recognized, pre-apprenticeship program provides students with a year of training in post-secondary apprenticeship programs, OSHA 10 certificate, First Aid, and CPR.
