2021 Financial Report: \$8,820.07 bank balance with rent for the year at IQM paid and deposit on retreat venue paid. Highlights from the financial report include 3 national speakers via Zoom - Cindy Grisdela, Irene Roderick, and Amy Friend. Amy Friend workshop, Christmas party at IQM, and 29 paid members for 2022. Income for the year was \$5,707.00. Expenses for the year were \$5,478.17 resulting in a net gain of \$228.83. Retreat income totaled \$3,220.00 and expenses were \$2,335.03 resulting in a profit of \$1,336.97. The TOM raffle so far is \$424.00.
