Drupal Sustainability Team: Strategy and Roadmap (working doc)

Introduction

As Drupal approaches its 23-year anniversary, it is crucial to address the pressing issue of sustainability within the Drupal ecosystem. We propose the establishment of the Drupal Sustainability Team, a formal team dedicated to making Drupal and its community leaders in sustainability. This Team aims to raise awareness about the environmental impact of web development, provide guidance for sustainable event organization, promote the development and use of eco-friendly themes and modules, and ensure economic sustainability for projects, groups, organizations, and individual contributors. By taking proactive measures, Drupal can set an example for other open-source projects and demonstrate its commitment to building a more sustainable and economically viable open web.

Rationale

Drupal has always strived to create a better web for everyone, and sustainability presents a new challenge that cannot be ignored. In addition to environmental concerns, it is essential to address the economic sustainability of projects, groups, organizations, and individual contributors within the Drupal community. Objectives

Eco-friendly Themes and Modules

Encourage the development and promotion of eco-friendly themes and modules within the Drupal ecosystem while also considering their economic viability. We will collaborate with module and theme developers to create guidelines for eco-friendly design and functionality, ensuring that economic considerations are incorporated. This includes evaluating the long-term economic sustainability of modules and themes, and potential revenue streams.

Economic Sustainability for Projects, Groups, Organizations, and Individual Contributors

Focus on the economic sustainability of Drupal projects, groups, organizations, and individual contributors within the ecosystem. Project Manager

Community Engagement Coordinator

Facilitates collaboration with existing Drupal teams and the wider community, fostering cross-team cooperation and participation.

Content and Communication Coordinator

Manages the creation and dissemination of educational materials, blog posts, and social media campaigns to raise awareness about sustainability and economic considerations.

Environmental Sustainability Specialist

Expert in environmental issues and sustainability practices, who can guide and advise on eco-friendly initiatives and strategies.

Event Sustainability Specialist

Experienced in sustainability of events, providing insights and recommendations for supporting events within the Drupal ecosystem.

Economic Sustainability Specialist

Experienced in financial and economic sustainability, providing insights and recommendations for supporting economic viability within the Drupal ecosystem.

Funding Requirements

Create a dedicated section on economic sustainability within the Drupal website, providing educational resources, best practices, and case studies on achieving economic sustainability in the context of Drupal projects, groups, organizations, and individual contributors. These resources will empower Drupal users and contributors to make informed decisions that consider both environmental and economic sustainability.

Strategic Partnership and Collaboration

Establish partnerships and solidify collaborations with projects, groups, initiatives, programs, and organizations with an overlap in focus, strategy, or support area.
