## Track and Field Booster Club Meeting Minutes

2/9/26

In attendance: Dave Jones, Ashley Jones, Alisha Good, Felicia Batten, Kelley Waninger, Joe Stair, Nick Mercadante, Yatra Annan

### Update from Coach Gutekunst

- Updates/2026 needs - new timing system: FAT system (automatic timing)
  - Sean Sebeck will be timer, meeting with Coach G weekly
  - This will be a learning curve this year with changes on the fly - possibility of hiring a second person for meets, one person running camera, one person doing meet management on computer
  - Meet management system needed: MeetPro or HiTec
    - MeetPro is less expensive and just as good as HiTec, connects with MileSplit
  - Boosters should be prepared for on-demand purchases needed for system (longer cords, weatherproofing, computer mouse, etc) - all one-time purchases
    - \$1000 will be set aside for on-demand timing purchases
    - Coach G will buy as needs arise then see if Athletic Dept will cover cost
  - Looking at options for storing the FAT system
    - Good's PE office is a possibility
    - Nick M. suggested Athletic Dept purchases lockable cages like the ones in the concession stand so items can be secure in the shed, Ashley J. will talk to Josh Luckenbaugh, Coach G will find out if the system could be stored outside in hot/cold temps
- Staffing Update
  - Fully staffed for Junior High and Varsity
    - New jump coach
    - Part time JH coach - ran at Dallastown
    - Ashley J. will update website with new hires
    - Two coaches currently splitting pay, Steve P (shot and disc) is basically full time so Boosters asked to supplement salary
  - Indoor participation - kids doing great and have been troopers despite not being able to be outside due to weather and doing hallway runs
  - Sign Ups Varsity #'s - over 100 signed up so far, 15-20 known kids haven't signed up yet  
Last year 170 signed up, started the season with 130

### Update from Coach B.

- Sign Ups - Junior High #'s - 100 sign ups so far

### Update from Coach Gutekunst

- Funds are exhausted from the district, 2 javelins need to be regripped - booster club will pay
- Excellent first week of practice in spite of circumstances with half day Thursday and no school Friday, great turnout
- 161 kids on roster, Coach G will email those who haven't shown up
- 178 Junior High sign ups, 130 showed up for practice
- Coaches are talking about cancelling the Suburban scrimmage due to cold weather, don't want injuries this early in the season
- Riyana Owens is being paid for part time coaching but has been consistently showing up in a full time capacity. The booster club is currently paying for half of the stipend for Steve Parago, so can we also pay the other half for Riyana? This will be voted on in April.
- Meet Pro is all set up for the timing system
- The camera broke - it was sent back to be repaired
- Pictures went well on Sunday, those who weren't able to attend will be photographed on Wednesday during practice

### Update from Coach Gutekunst

- Teams are doing very well
- Timing system worked well for the first use during York High meet
  - We now have a second person (Matt Strebog) working with Sebeck at each meet, one person will run cameras, one person will input athletes
  - Coach Gutekunst will work with JH coaches to show timing system

### Treasurer Report

- Nick is out of town but Ashley gave his report
- Fundraising update: Spirit Wear brought in over \$600, no update on Kona Ice to date
- Season sponsors will bring in \$2800
  - 7 of 12 season sponsors renewed at \$400 each
  - We are waiting on payment from Parma, Heritage Hills, and Culhanes
  - Sebeck Physiotherapy has paid
  - Ashley will give Nick credit card numbers for TruAdvantage, Sheepdog and Coach B when he returns
  - Banners will be hung at meets and business logos will be on Ray Geesey shirts

### Coaching Update

- Coach Perago and Coach Owens are paid for part time but putting in full time hours, both go above and beyond
- Proposal from the board: cover the other half of both salaries to make them full time coaches
- VOTE: Motion - Dave Jones, 2nd - Felicia Batten; unanimous vote
- Two full time sprint coaches are needed at the JH level for the number of sprinters on team

- Can the booster club pay for salaries? Coach Gutekunst will have a conversation with Josh and Coach B

## **Fundraising Update**

- Booster Club Membership: 34% participation = 92 families (up from 30% last year)
  - \$2750 plus additional donations
  - Missing forms from 2 families, missing payment from 8 families (but there are unnamed credit card receipts that may belong to those families)
- Popcorn Loft fundraiser ends on 4/17, but due to invitationals we are asking forms and money to be turned into coaches by Thursday, 4/16.
  - Orders can also be dropped off at the concession stand on Tuesday, 4/14 during the home meet. Kelley Waninger will collect orders from the concession stand at the end of the meet on Tuesday and also be at the end of practice on Thursday, 4/16 to collect orders from parents and coaches
  - Distribution will be 5/7, 4:30-6:00 at the stadium
- Ray Geesey Fundraising
  - T-shirt sales: ordered and ready for pick up on 4/20-4/21
    - Purchased for \$7/\$8 from 2 the Tee, selling for \$15
    - 3 color options - gray (from last year), navy, or light blue
  - Event Sponsors -36 events sponsored so far (\$25/event, \$50/relay)
    - Email will be going out this week about sponsorships
    - If all events are sponsored = \$1050+ (up to 3 sponsors per event)
    - Yard signs will be displayed with sponsor's name attached

### Update from Coach Gutekunst

- Coaches pay goes out at the end of May, then we will know how much boosters will supplement for Coach Riyana and Coach Steve

### Treasurer Report

- Balance: \$50,978 plus \$3800 in Venmo
- Scholarships (~\$3000) and coaches supplemental pay (~\$2500) still to come out of budget
- Switching to Intuit @ \$19/month for 3 months then \$38/month
- Discussed Square fees - depends on the card, flat fee plus percentage
- \$2000 spent on MACFAT timing for Ray Geesey

### Fundraising Update

- Kona Ice: ~\$800
- Season Sponsors - waiting on Heritage Hills (Dave Jones will follow up) and Parma (Nick will ask if that money can be taken off what's owed for pizza)
- Photographer: gave \$440 back to boosters
- Ask Coach Gutekunst if there are any big purchases on the horizon?
  - Need: 3-4 vaulting poles
  - What will be the best use of money - renting or buying? Will that come from athletic budget?

### Ray Geesey Update

- HUGE SUCCESS! Biggest RG meet to date
  - 34 pizzas, 176 walking tacos, 318 sodas, 212 pretzels, 349 Chic-Fil-A sandwiches
- Event Sponsors: \$1200 total
  - Ashley Jones will send Thank You emails to event sponsors
- Net Totals ~\$14,000 in all
  - Concessions: \$7800
  - T-Shirts: \$2200

- Officials and Volunteer meals - keep grab & go boxed meals for next year
- Suggestions for next year
  - 2 squares for tshirt sales
  - Signage for directions to throwing events
  - Post a map at admissions table

### **YAIAA Counties Update**
