Aki Studio is available for performance rentals, and flexible enough to become your new favourite venue for special events. In keeping with the values of Native Earth, it was imperative in the planning of this venue to create an accessible, functional and safe space in which to nurture our growing artist and patron base. Aki Studio is equipped with a comprehensive technical rig with flexible seating arrangements. Though our capacity is 120, a standard proscenium configuration comfortably allows 118 seats. Our backstage boasts two dressing rooms, a wheelchair accessible bathroom and laundry facilities. Aki Studio is fully

accessible for both patrons and performers. Our front of house has box office and ticketing services, including online box office.

- 40 hours of Technician time per week
- In-house Lighting & Sound Equipment
- Box Office Services, general admission
- Front of House Staffing (including bartender, where applicable) for all performances within TPM's regular schedule
- One private dressing room & a shared greenroom backstage

Additional fees include:

- Staffing costs for lighting hang/load in or strike
- Third-Party Insurance (proof of insurance required prior to load-in)
- FOH Staffing fees for any scheduled performances that divert from TPM's regular schedule (Wed – Sat @ 7:30 pm, Sat & Sun Matinees @ 2 pm)
- Additional tech time outside of 40 hours are subject to infringement costs, and additional technicians are generally charged at a rate of \$27/hr plus HST per technician.

Theatre Passe Muraille's Bob Nasmith Innovation Backspace theatre is an intimate black-box studio space within our designated heritage building, just Northeast of Queen & Bathurst. The Backspace has a maximum seating capacity of 40-45 (retractable seating).

Notes: The Theatre Centre is a nationally recognized live-arts incubator and community hub. Our mission is to offer a home for creative, cultural and social interactions to invent the future. We make work that spans disciplines and genres; work that pushes the boundaries of what is considered "art". Our programming and our role as a community space are inextricably linked. Art is not made in a silo: it is connected to the world around it. We offer one of the only spaces in the neighbourhood where folks can pop in for a coffee, spend the day working, or just hang out (no purchase necessary). It is a community hub and a place to gather; a place where you —

regardless of class, race, ethnicity, religion, or ability — are welcome to be. You don't have to identify as an artist or performer to use the space. We want you to feel at home here. We believe art is political. We believe resources go further when you share them. We believe cultural spaces are public spaces. We believe in offering artists time—time to try, time to fail, time to discover all of the things their ideas will not become.

The Franco Boni Theatre is our largest performance space, on the building's upper level next to the Gallery. It has a sprung floor covered with black-painted Masonite. Some of its distinctive features include high ceilings, tall windows facing Queen Street and the buildings to our East and West, architectural wall and ceiling textures, and a heritage double door at the North side of the building. Its seating areas, technical inventory, and stage layout are not fixed, which gives artists many flexible options for use. Whether they keep the space wide open, or draw it close for intimacy, many have found the Franco Boni Theatre a complimentary venue for their work, whether that is presented in the round, as an environmental installation, or in the 'fourth wall' style.

The BMO Incubator is our most intimate performance space located on the ground floor next to the Theatre Centre Café/Bar. Don't let its size fool you – the BMO incubator is an incredibly versatile space! This is due to the large "pit" that takes up the majority of the space. The "pit" is located in the centre of the room about 2 feet below the concrete border and has a black painted masonite semi-sprung floor. Thanks to this architecture, the BMO Incubator has built-in levels, and allows for a multitude of unique, accessible, set-ups. The Incubator's intimate nature lends itself to strong, innovative, unusual work that engages the audience in close quarters.
