



French 10-9Y (5 credits)

Prerequisite: FSL 9-9Y

For students who have successfully completed French 9-9Y in junior high school, this course builds on prior knowledge and enhances vocabulary, listening, speaking, reading and writing. Some of the fields of experience are activities, shopping, vacations, fine arts, and safety (optional).

French 20-9Y (5 credits)

Prerequisite: French 10-9Y

For students who have successfully completed French 10-9Y, this course builds on prior knowledge and enhances vocabulary, listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Some of the fields of experience are senses and feeling, close friends, fads and fashions, consumerism, and outdoor life.

French 30-9Y (5 credits)

Prerequisite: French 20-9Y

For students who have successfully completed French 20-3Y/9Y, this course meets the requirements for university entrance. Emphasis is

placed on listening comprehension, speaking, reading comprehension, and writing. Some of the fields of experience are world of work, trips, or student exchanges, money, role of media, conservation, and the environment. Students also have the option of completing the DELF examination, which assesses their level of French in four competencies.

French Immersion Students

For those students leaving French Immersion programs in junior high school, but wish to remain in French programming, may enroll in French 30-9Y.
