

3-2-1: ACSD Progress Reports

Three Things to Know about Progress Reports.

1. Progress Reports- Progress Reports go home today. This report will present a summary of your child's learning and development to date. The reports are designed around the national academic standards. The reports will focus on a student's progress toward meeting grade level standards. Teachers are reporting on a student's academic progress and progress in the Approaches to Learning (ATL) skills. The ATL skills focus on students developing self knowledge and skills they need to engage in lifelong learning: social skills, self-management skills, communication skills, thinking skills, and research skills.

2. The Approaches to Learning will be determined using the following criteria:

4	Student consistently demonstrates this skill.
3	Student demonstrates this skill most of the time.
2	Student demonstrates this skill some of the time.
1	Student does not yet demonstrate this skill.

3. Academic Subject indicators will be determined using the following criteria:

5	Student applies deep knowledge and understanding of grade level standards fluently across contexts.
4	Student meets the end of year grade level standards independently.
3	Student is working steadily toward meeting grade level standards independently.
2	Student is beginning to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of grade level standards.
1	Student has not yet begun to work on the grade level standards.
N/A	Not addressed-Standard not addressed or not assessed this term.

Two Things to Remember:

1. The standards are goals for the end of the year, so students may not yet have met all components within a standard, but may have made progress toward that standard.
2. Please keep in mind that though there are 5 possible indicators, **a 3 means students are working steadily toward meeting grade level standards independently.**
