Pricing

Booking:

- Once you've picked what package you would like, go ahead and go to my [calendar link](#), also on my linktree, and book your chosen session.
- After you have booked your date, you are required to venmo a *non-refundable* fee to @reese-waller on venmo. This fee is ½ half of your session's total cost. Your date will not be reserved without the fee being paid.
 - *Non-refundable?* The only way this is refundable is due to my cancellation.
 - *What about the weather?* Weather is unpredictable and if I have to cancel due to weather, I will reschedule your session.
 - If you need to cancel, please reach out to me! We can definitely work something out.
- Once you've paid you are all set until your session date!
- The other half of the payment can be made after the session, but you will not receive photos until it has been paid in full.

About the session:

Mini session:

- 30-40 minutes– if we hit an hour that's fine, but no more than 60 minutes.
- Locations: We will fit as many locations in as we can, but we do have limited time.

Standard, Group, Couples:

- Should take 1 Hour and 30 minutes to 2 hours
- Locations: We should be able to fit Arch, Chapel, Bell, the Stadium, and one extra location.
- If you are doing a Standard session, you will have time for one outfit change.

The Arch

Please read if you want pictures at the Arch. If you do not care to have photos at the Arch DM me to let me know.

- If you would like photos at the Arch you are responsible for getting there at a good time. Now that we are getting closer to May, I would recommend getting to the Arch 1 hour before your session.
- If you have a weekend session, try to get there 1 hour to 1 ½ hours early. I know it sounds insane, but trust me it gets crazy.
- Lots of people like to bring a friend to stand with them so that when I arrive we can go and get other photos while they wait.
