Requirements: All students must: a current NYC resident, Be enrolled in the seventh grade in a NYC district school or charter school, Score a minimum of 3.25 or above on the ELA 2024 grade 6 New York State ELA Test and a 3.31 or above on the grade 6 New York State Math Test. AND - Live and attend school in NYC school districts 2 and meet income requirements based on federal guidelines, as informed by the family income inquiry form, completed by families for their schools in the fall. If your child is eligible, you will see the DREAM-SHSI
