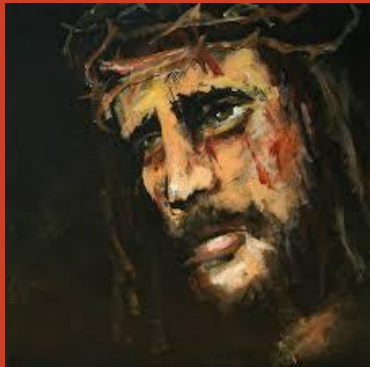


WITHOUT BEGINNING,
WITHOUT END



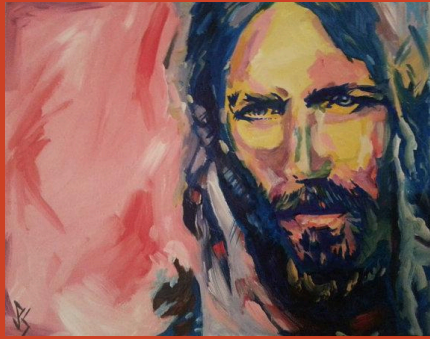
*He who is without beginning,
