 - Description of primary expenses
 - Biggest expense is the electricity for streetlights and entrance sign lights
 - There are 2 Laurens Electric charges per month...

 - This totals about ~\$143 per month
 - Insurance premium on the sign is \$586
 - Deductible for sign replacement is \$500
 - Sign was rebuilt around the year 2000
 - A resident has been volunteering to maintain the plants around the sign
 - Plants cost about \$200 total for the year
 - Lee Kazian has offered to continue the maintenance of the plants around the entrance sign
 - Sign lights will also need of repair
 - Parts should be \$75 -\$100
