Eligibility

Two scholarships are awarded annually, the first to an entering student and the second to a continuing student. In each case, the recipient serves as a student representative on the LISAA executive. Any recipient is eligible for a maximum of two awards.

The first scholarship is awarded on the basis of outstanding academic performance and professional potential to a student entering the MLIS program who enrolls in at least four courses during the regular academic year (Fall and Winter terms combined). The student's application to the program should demonstrate a balance between community engagement, personal commitments and scholastic life.

The second scholarship is awarded annually to a student continuing in the MLIS program who enrolls in at least four courses during the regular academic year (described above). It is granted on the basis of the completion of at least four courses and satisfactory academic progress. The recipient of the entering student scholarship is eligible for consideration, subject to the recommendation of the executive committee of the Alumni Association (president, past president, and vice-president/president-elect). Their approval will be based on satisfactory performance of duties and obligations on the LISAA executive during the first year.

Application

A call for applications will be sent to the student mailing lists. Eligible students for both scholarships will be considered by the School and the LISAA executive.
