

# Choosing Courses for Grade 10

First, plan the courses you will be requesting. ALL Grade 10 students must take 8 courses for the year

## Start by selecting the following compulsory courses.

- English- choose ENG 2D1 (Academic) or ENG2P1 (Applied) or ENG2L1 (Locally Developed) or ESL
  - This decision should be based on the recommendation of your Grade 9 English teacher.
- Math – choose MPM2D1 (Academic) or MFM2P1 (Applied) or MAT2L1 (Locally Developed)
  - This decision should be based on the recommendation of your Grade 9 English teacher.
- Science- choose SNC2D1 (Academic) or SNC2P1 (Applied) or SNC2L1(Locally Developed)
- Religion - HRE2O1
- Canadian History- CHC2D1 or CHC2P1
- 0.5 Civics & 0.5 Careers (choose CARCIV)- list in myBlueprint under Guidance
- Technology- TGJ2O1- Communication Technology (Open Level)
  - This course will satisfy the new Tech requirement. This is the only Tech course that SJMP offers that meets the guidelines.

## Then select 1 elective courses:

NOTE: If you did not take PPL1O1 in grade 9, you should choose PPL2O1 as your first elective since you must earn one physical education credit for the OSSD. If you did not take an Art credit in grade 9, you should choose one as your first elective since you must earn one art credit for the OSSD.

- ADA2O1 - Drama
- AMI2O1 - Instrumental Music
- AMV2O1 - Vocal
- AVI2O1 - Visual Arts
- ELS2O1 - Literacy Skills Reading & Writing
- FSF2D1 - Academic French or FSF 2P1 Applied French
- HFN2O1 - Food and Nutrition
- PPL2O1- Physical Education

## THEN, CHOOSE TWO ALTERNATES:

Students must choose two alternatives. This will be used if courses are unavailable or there are conflicts. Many students will be scheduled into at least one alternate.
