
- 1) Connect to wifi
- 2) Sign up for an OpenStreetMap account if you don't have one: <https://www.openstreetmap.org/user/new>
- 3) Select a task (area to edit)
  - a) Go to: <https://tasks.hotosm.org/>
  - b) Login to OpenStreetMap
    - i) Click "login to OpenStreetMap" (upper right corner)
    - ii) Enter username and password, <enter>
    - iii) Click 
  - c) Search for "1544" (upper left corner of page)
  - d) Click on title
  - e) Click on "Instructions" button - read instructions.
  - f) Click on "Start contributing" at bottom of instructions.
  - g) Click a square on the map on the right side of the screen (i.e. a "task")
  - h) Click on 
  - i) Click on  select "iD Editor" (If you are experienced with OSM and prefer to use a different editor, that is ok).
- 4) Edit!
  - a) General
    - i) Purple box outlines the task area you have selected - try to edit within.
    - ii) Left click & drag to move the map
    - iii) Scroll wheel to zoom in/out
  - b) To draw a building
    - i) click on  Area near the top of the screen
    - ii) Click on each corner of the building you wish to draw.
    - iii) Click a second time on the last corner to finish
    - iv) Upper left of the screen, search for the building category, click on the category (building)  

    - v) Click on the type of building (generic "building")  

    - vi) To square a building,  
(1) click on it to select it

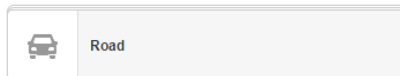

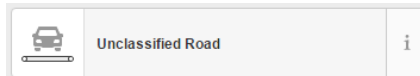
- (2) Click 2nd time to bring up context menu:
- (3) Click on the “square icon” (circled in red in above image).

c) To draw a road

- i) Click on  near top of screen
- ii) Click along the road
- iii) Double click the final point




- iv) Left panel, click on
- v) Scroll down



- vi) Click on

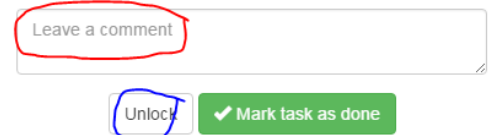


- d) Save every few minutes! Click  at the top of the map.
  - i) In the “Changeset comment” in addition to the text already displayed, add #UNC\_Colorado.

e) Attempt to map all buildings and highways in the task.

5) Unlock task. When you have done as much as you can (or at the end of the evening), go back to the tasking manager (should still be open in a tab on your browser).

- a) Enter a comment, such as “still some things left that might be buildings”
- b) Click “unlock” if you finished the task (all buildings in the area have been drawn, click “Mark task as done”
