Reminders

- Do NOT schedule DEN
- Do NOT schedule co-taught classes for any student who is not sped or whose placement page does not indicate co-taught for that specific class.
- Typical: English, Math, World Geography, Biology, PE/Health
- Health has been added. You will complete PE. Do not adjust gen ed vs. CoT vs. sheltered. Health semesters may be adjusted sparingly.
- If during conversation, a family indicates that the student is currently struggling in multiple classes and would like more assistance, you may schedule SRC.
- Remind families of the deadline for changes.
- Remind families that electives are not guaranteed. Effort will be made to accommodate all requests, but it's possible that students may not get their top choices.
- Ensure that you have PLENTY of alternate electives so that we do not have to call families as we resolve conflicts.

Acceleration / Deceleration

- Deceleration - Students may decelerate. Complete paperwork. Turn into Dawn. Make adjustments when the approval is returned.
- Acceleration - DO NOT MAKE CHANGE. Complete paperwork. Turn into Dawn. Dawn will forward to appropriate DH. Upon approval and return of paperwork, adjustments will be made. Dawn will ask DHs to contact parents if approval is not granted.

ESL Placements

[Newcomer/DLP Elective Options \(ESL 1 or 2\)](#)

- Do NOT adjust placements! If families insist on removing a support, explain that placements are meant to support the student in having a very successful start to high school. If after the first semester, the support is no longer needed, students can adjust their schedule. Also, explain that students will be taking their ACCESS test in the spring with the middle school. At that time, our ESL Department will review scores and classes may be adjusted if the support is no longer needed. Encourage students to select

alternate options that can be used in that case, or that you can note for following years. Point out that elective space that is available over the course of four years as requirements are met.

SPED Placements

- Do NOT adjust placements! If there is a concern with a placement, reach out to Megan/Jim on behalf of the family to review.
- Do NOT schedule co-taught classes for any student who is not sped or whose placement page does not indicate co-taught for that specific class.
- There are a handful of missing placements from each school. If placements are missing, assure the family that the DH of SPED is working with the middle school (end of January) to finalize placements. Provide an overview of the core classes and be sure to gather elective options that can be used if there is room in the schedule. Please make a note of those schedules that need to be complete. Dawn will assist in gathering final placements.
