You Alzheimer's Questions, Answered (Working Title)

Project Description:

This project will be a video series about the common questions that caregivers have when taking care of someone with a memory disorder. It will function as a resource that they can refer to when they want to learn more about specific memory disorder topics, including how to manage specific behaviors. It will also function as a training tool for new social workers unfamiliar with memory disorders.

Organization:

Memory Disorder Clinic of West Florida Hospital.

Project Goals:

The goal of the project will be to create a video series to function as a resource to answer the common questions of the caregivers of memory disorder patients. It will act as a resource they will be able to come back to. After finishing the video series, learners will have a greater understanding of how to better accommodate the person suffering from a memory disorder.

Deliverables:

- 3 short videos on common questions regarding memory disorders:
 1. When should someone come into the Memory Disorder Clinic?
 2. Can a person with Alzheimer's drive?
 3. How do you manage agitation?

ID Model Used:

ADDIE (Analyze, Design, Develop, Implement, Evaluate)

The ADDIE model is a generic, flexible instructional design model that allows for a systematic development of learning materials. During this project, evaluation will also occur during the Development process to allow for changes to be made before the formal evaluation process.

How the finished product will be used:

The finished product will be a resource available online for the caretakers to access on their own time. It will be hosted on a video-sharing platform.

Evaluation:

This project will be evaluated by caregivers of those already suffering from memory disorders through a brief questionnaire. The questionnaire will be distributed through the Memory Disorder Clinic to allow the target learners to provide feedback.

Instructional Designer's role within the project:

To film, edit, and create the videos. The videos will be hosted on Youtube and will be displayed on the Medical Disorder Clinic homepage. I plan on using my knowledge of Adult Learning Theory to help structure the content so that it is easily digestible for the target demographic (age 50 – 70), and my knowledge of Mayer's Multimedia Principles to ensure that the information is disseminated in a readable format.
