

Child Development Syllabus

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Course Description:

Child Development is a technical laboratory course that addresses knowledge and skills related to child growth and development from prenatal through school-age children, equipping students with child development skills. Students use these skills to promote the well-being and healthy development of children and investigate careers related to the care and education of children.

Progress Reports:

Progress reports will be handed out every 3rd week of the grading period. Any student with a grade of 75 or below will be required to have a parent/guardian sign and return the progress report. If there are any questions or concerns, please feel free to call me at any time.

Grading Policy:

Major projects/ Journal: 50%

Daily work/ Class discussions: 50%

Attendance:

Attendance is very important for student success. Projects, labs and classroom assignments are difficult to make up so students need to maintain good attendance in order to be successful in this class.

Make-up and Late work:

All class assignments are due at the beginning of the assigned due date. Students will follow the following late work penalty procedures:

One Day -10 point deduction, Two Days -20 point deduction, Three Days -No credit

When a student is absent it is their responsibility to obtain their make-up work. Students have three days to turn in make-up work after they return to school.

Retakes:

Students will be allowed to redo an assignment the last week of each 6 weeks and receive a grade no higher than a 70.
