Let's learn a little today about what it means to be humble. Grab your Bible and read Matthew 23:1-12.

The Pharisees were wanting people to follow rules. That's not a bad thing, but what was bad is that they thought they were better than other people because they followed the rules better. God wants us to love people, right? We learned about that last week and many other weeks too! Being 'humble' is one way we can love people and the Pharisees were NOT being humble by thinking they were better than others.

Jesus teaches us that community is important. That means we are part of something bigger and that it is not 'all about me!' Ask your mom or dad if you have some popcorn kernels. Have each member of your family put a popcorn kernel in a bowl and say "I am important." Each member of a community is important, but that means that not any one person is most important. Remember to love others by thinking of them first. Every popcorn kernel is part of a yummy snack, but you need many kernels to make it a snack, just like we need many people to make a community!

Humility is thinking of others more than you think of yourself.

Humility is not building yourself up.

Humility is not about thinking yourself less but thinking less about yourself.
