INTRODUCTION (12 pt, Bold)

This section should be written in English, 1,5 spaced, typed with TNR font, size 12, and justified margin alignment. The introduction contains general background, problem formulation (derived from the disagreement between empirical reality / "das sein" and ideal / "das sollen" conditions), research (gaps/voids resulting from the review of previous studies on the related topic), research novelty/contribution, the author's main argument, and the purpose of writing the article. The first line of the second paragraph and the following paragraphs are written indented.

LITERATURE REVIEW (12 pt, Bold)

A literature review represents previous research on the research topic being discussed and also the theoretical core of an article. The purpose of a literature review is to "re-view" at what other researchers have done on a particular topic. The literature review is a means to an end, namely to provide background and serve as motivation for the objectives and hypotheses that guide one's research. A good literature review not only provides a summary of relevant previous research; researchers are also expected to critically evaluate, reorganize, and synthesize the work of others. The literature review

should identify knowledge gaps identified by the author during the literature review and develop a theoretical explanation that addresses the research questions and objectives.

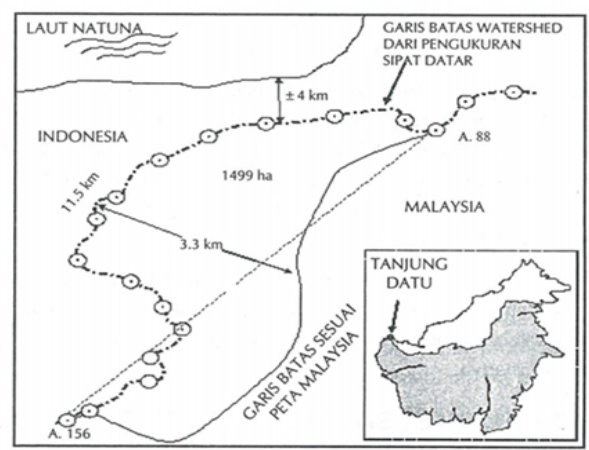
METHODS (12 pt, Bold)
