Millionaire Mind Kids (MMK) Summer Programs are OPEN FOR REGISTRATION and limited seats are quickly filled. The following programs' offerings from June 10, 2023 through July 31 2023 are summarized below. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math & ROBOTICS): June 10 through June 14 (Ages 9-13)

five days: An introductory program to First Lego League Robotics for students who have a high interest in learning how STEM is relevant to ROBOTICS, Engineering, and Technology Careers. Teams will be chosen to compete in US First Lego League Competitions.

(Limited to 50 participants)

EARLY APPLICATION DEADLINE, MAY 25: Law and Justice Academy: June 17—June 21 (Ages 13—18) five days: a Millionaire Mind Kids and San Bernardino County's Law and Justice Agencies (Public Defender, Sheriff/Coroner, and Probation) have collaborated to design and implement the Law and Justice Academy for high-school students, ages 13 through 18. The five-day summer program goals are to expose students to the various careers and opportunities within the Law and Justice Sectors; cultivate students' interest who desire to serve their community; and inspire students to excel in school while preventing them from becoming a product of the criminal justice system. A short essay is required stating your interest in Law and Justice and why you would like to attend this program **(Limited to 25 participants)**. **Note: Early application deadline is due to screening requirements.**

Aviation Career Education (ACE): June 1—June 21 (orientation flight on July 7) six days: This 11-day program is for students who have a high interest in learning more about careers in aviation and aerospace. Students will also experience an orientation flight. A short essay is required stating your interest in aviation and why you would like to attend this program.
(Limited to 25 participants).

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) (ROBOTICS CENTERED): July 8—12 (Ages 13-18 High School Students Only) five days: This camp is an advanced STEM/Robotics program for high-school students who have a high interest in learning how STEM is relevant to ROBOTICS, Engineering, and Technology Careers. Teams will be chosen to compete in First Tech Challenge Competitions

Financial Literacy: July 16—21 (Ages 13—18 Middle and High School Students) five days: Empower yourself through developing money management & life skills. Learn to become a “SMART Money Manager and Credit responsible: **(Limited to 50 participants)**

Scholarship Academy: July 22—July 26 (Ages 14—18 High School Students) The Millionaire Mind Kids Scholarship Academy is a five-day Program, designed for serious college-bound high-school students who are Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) Majors. Students will learn the components of successful scholarship writing. STEM Major seniors will write actual Scholarships.
