## J. R. Tucker MCJROTC Variance Procedures

1. Zoned for J. R. Tucker high school?

Student signs up for "Military Science I" via their school counselor.

- 2. Zoned for a high school other than J. R. Tucker?
  - -Students must gain approval from the principal of the high school he/she is zoned to attend
  - -Fill out variance form:

https://www.henricoschools.us/page/school-assignment-variance and deliver it to the zoned high school's main office for approval.

- 3. Once the variance is approved by the zoned high school's principal, the variance form will be sent to J. R. Tucker administration office for review..
- 4. J. R. Tucker Admin will notify LtCol Gaitens of the candidate.
- 5. At this point, LtCol Gaitens will request the student's grades and attendance, and discipline records to help determine whether the student is eligible to be enrolled as a cadet in the school's program. If not eligible, the student will automatically be 'NOT ENDORSED'
- 6. Those found 'eligible,' will then be contacted as prospective cadet's. The parents/guardians will arrange a meeting to discuss the MCJROTC program. Parents must bring to this meeting:
  - \*lease/mortgage statement (most current, within 6months)
  - \* utility bill (most current, within 6months)
  - \* State/Gov't ID (Non-expired)
- 7. After the meeting, should the prospective cadet meet the criteria for MCJROTC enrollment, all forms with JROTC 'endorsement letter' will be sent to J. R. Tucker's principal for approval/denial.
- 8. From this point, all information will go to Henrico County for processing and notification.
