Chromebooks and Library Books

Please look around the house and send in any school library books ASAP. Any books checked out to your child that are not returned will result in a fine that is equal to the replacement cost of the book.

Attention 6th Grade Parents - Time for Immunizations!

State law requires all incoming 7th grade students to be vaccinated against Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (TDAP) as well as Meningococcal Conjugate before starting the school year. Students who do not have up-to-date immunizations may be excluded from attending school. Many students have already received these required vaccines during a well-child visit to their primary care provider. Parents and guardians can find out if a child has had these vaccines by looking at the child's vaccine record or by checking with the family's primary care physician. If you have an objection to any of the immunizations that are required by the Michigan Public Health Code, please contact the Shiawassee County Health Department to complete the process of obtaining an immunization waiver. This waiver must also be completed and submitted to the office by the start of the school year. Please consider making sure your child has his/her shots or a waiver ASAP to avoid having them miss school this fall. Thank you in advance for your help with getting this completed on time!

Pre-Pandemic Medicaid Renewal Process

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has asked local school districts to please inform parents that the state is returning to its pre-pandemic Medicaid renewal processes. The flyers let parents know that if they are contacted by MDHHS with a Medicaid renewal form, they should make sure their contact information is correct, complete the form, and send it in so there is no disruption in Medicaid coverage.

P-EBT Cards for 2021-2022
