Please do not allow your child to play in the playground after pick-up to give us ample time to clean the playground and sanitise the equipment for the following day.

Some children have been arriving at school late in the morning. This causes your child to be unsettled and creates a distraction for the other children. The morning session is a very important time of the day when children are most alert and more susceptible to learning. Please make sure your child is at school by 7:30 AM.
