How to host your own workshop:

THE 5WH

1. Who
 - anyone!! This event is suitable for everyone, people could walk or bike to spread seeds of having experienced any physical difficulties, but pretty much any able body person!!
 - It could be people in your community, volunteers, etc
2. What
 - Distribute **native** plant seeds using a **salt sprinkler**
3. When
 - whenever you want, wherever you want!!
 - TEDI team is planning to host the campaign during June, but it's a fun and easy campaign to do year-round, because all you do is sprinkle some native seeds on the grass you see near you!!
4. Where
 - Local grass fields, parks, nature reserves
 - Public and privately accessible open spaces
 - Priority on areas needing ecological restoration or low pollinator populations
5. Why
 - inexpensive
 - Fun
 - For a good cause: makes great environmental impacts
 - Easy to do!!
 - Improve pollinator habitats, especially for bees
 - Restore native plants and wildflowers to local ecosystems
 - Enhance biodiversity
 - Support pollinators like bees, crucial for ecosystem health
6. How
 - Volunteers use a **handheld salt sprinkler** to spread seeds while walking or biking when passing by available space for seeding
 - Campaign promoted through local media and social networks to encourage community participation
