I. Call to order

Angela Jackson, Township Clerk, called to order the annual meeting of the Fairview Township at 7:00 pm on March 3, 2026.

II. Roll call

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting and Agenda for Annual Meeting

Minutes from March 6, 2025, annual meeting were read and approved as read. Minutes from the February 24, 2026, regular meeting were read and approved as read.

Agenda approved by supervisors.

IV. New business

- a) Time for open public comment and visitors to be heard-
 - i) Jeremy Gobell of 32015 Cusick Street, Burbank, presented signed documents for vacation of a portion of Madison Street adjoining his property. All taxes have been paid. Max Anderson made a motion to proceed to vacate the street. Second by Mike Seiner. Approved. Clerk to put public notice in the paper for 2 weeks for the public comment meeting for March 31st.
 - ii) Motion to pay for ad in legal paper by Mike Seiner. Seconded by Max Anderson.
- b) Max Anderson made a motion to re-elect Mike Seiner to a position on the Board of Supervisors. Todd Mockler the motion. All were in agreement. Approved. Mike Seiner has rotated into the role as the chairperson.
- c) Mike Seiner made a motion to elect Jamie Neitzke to the position of Treasurer. Max Anderson 2nd the motion. All were in agreement. Approved. Jamie Neitzke took the oath of office and was sworn in as Treasurer.

- d) Mike Seiner made a motion to re-elect Angela Jackson to the position of Clerk. Todd Mockler 2nd the motion. All were in agreement. Approved. Angela Jackson took the oath of office and was sworn in as Clerk.
- e) Treasurer reviewed and presented the annual report. Max Anderson made a motion to approve the annual statement. Todd Mockler seconded the motion. All were in agreement. Approved.
- f) Bills were presented to be paid for \$719.20 including payroll. No deposits. Motion to approve Max Anderson. Seconded by Mike Seiner. Approved.
- g) County Weed Contract - Motion to approve by Mike Seiner. Second by Todd Mockler. Approved.
- h) Two gravel bids were received and read by Mike Seiner from Pollman bid \$15.63/ton crushed gravel and \$24.76/ton for crushed concrete. Mike Seiner made the motion to accept the bid for Pollman as supplier. Second by Max Anderson. All were in agreement. Approved.
- i) Wages for Maintainer – no changes from last year. Maintained at \$25/hour for one more year.
- j) Wages for additional staff time - Mike Seiner made a motion to set the salary for additional time provided by the supervisors during emergency situations and over the scope of their job descriptions at \$20/hr. and for additional time over the scope of their job descriptions for Clerk and Treasurer at \$20/hr. Max Anderson 2nd the motion. All were in agreement. Approved.
- k) Snow removal and gravel needs - There were no changes made from the previous year's snow plan and maintenance funds.
- l) SB1 Levy - Mike Seiner made a motion to apply for SB1 levy at \$ 0.50/thousand for road and bridge improvements and \$200,000 or maximum for the general fund. 2nd by Max Anderson. All were in agreement. Approved.
- m) Todd Mockler made the motion to continue the Legal paper for notices as the Broadcaster press and Plaintalk. 2nd by Mike Seiner. Motion approved.
- n) Max Anderson made the motion to set the rate for charging Prairie Center mowing rate at \$100/hour plus fuel. Seconded by Mike Seiner. Approved.
- o) Large equipment purchase - one 1981 John Deere 4440 tractor for \$29,500 delivered to Vermillion from Tyler Coburn. Motion to purchase by Todd Mockler. Second by Max Anderson. Approved.
- p) Review of open meeting laws. Angela Jackson, Clerk, read the Guide to South Dakota's Open Meeting Laws.
