Course Description

Students in Advanced Sculpture will build on the knowledge learned in Sculpture. This course is project-based and success depends on effort demonstrated by the student to commit to the creative process and the quality of their art work. Advanced Sculpture is designed to continue an in depth, intensive study of three dimensional arts, while practicing and mastering techniques and concepts previously learned. Students are expected to apply higher level skills to clay and other mixed media. Students will be introduced to new concepts and learn to problem solve artistic outcomes. Students may be required to give peer assessments, presentations, and critiques throughout the course.

Grading

Students are graded in 2 main areas: Projects and Participation

Projects:

This may include, but is not limited to: craftsmanship, application of skill, use of classroom time, growing and improving artistic skills, photographing, and submitting completed assignments.

Participation:

This may include, but is not limited to: sketches, video/article reviews, class critiques, self reflections, portfolio building, studio maintenance/safety, and group discussions.
