#### **What's happening in elections this week**

- The [Presidential transition](#) is underway, an established process for ensuring a peaceful and smooth transfer of power
- On [November 15](#), North Carolina's county boards of elections will certify votes, making all NC votes official (unless there is a recount or other official action needed in a race). After that, NC electors meet on December 17 to vote on North Carolina's choice for President and Vice President.
- At Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, [Providence High School Lucy Silverstein was elected by districtwide high school student vote to be 2025 Student Advisor to the Board of Education.](#)
