Genius Hour Presentation Outline

Here is what needs to be addressed throughout your presentation. Make it interesting. You have already done the thinking for these questions, now you just have to make it **exciting** for your audience. You may want to create a short video, Powerpoint, Presi, etc. Make sure to include project samples or even better bring in the real thing.

- Briefly explain what your genius project was about, what question were you exploring.
- 2. Explain what you learned through your research. What did you know when you started and what have you learned now?
- 3. What have you created/made/built for your project? What did you do with your learning? (examples a prototype for solving a problem, a portfolio of pictures or crafts, a collection of music samples that show music through history)
- 4. How does this project benefit other people? **OR** Where will you take your learning next? (We are encouraging you to be global citizens, how does your work on your project reach beyond you? Will you donate the blankets you made to a homeless shelter? Will you organize a food drive? Will you donate your time and services (the new skill you learned) somewhere? **OR** What new questions do you now have because of your learning? What will your next project be?)
- 5. Reflect on yourself as a learner, what did you learn about your yourself as a result of completing this assignment? (Think about your strengths; how you overcame your weaknesses?).
