

Dart League Rules

(Revised 07/2023)

Format:

- 1. Games are paid for by the league/bar.
- 2. NO METAL TIPS ALLOWED
- 3. League Format
 - a. CRICKET LEAGUE (Wed) matches will be best 2 of 3 games.
 - b. MIXED LEAGUE (Wed) Game 1: Cricket, Game 2: 501, Game 3: 1 person from each team shoots for closest to Bullseye. Winner has a choice of game or to shoot first.
 - i. Rec Cricket, 501(open in/out), choice
 - ii. Competitive-Cricket, 501(open in/double out), choice
 - c. Both leagues are "double header leagues" you will play 2 matches a night
 - d. Loser shoots first
- 4. Team play will be doubles with players alternating shots.
- 5. Please fill out your scorecards directly after your match and turn your score card into the coordinator. Failure to turn in a completed score card may result in a double forfeit.
- 6. Each week a \$10 bar tab will be awarded to the team to close out a game in the fewest rounds. Should a tie happen, that bar tab will push to the following week.
- 7. Treat staff, players and the bar with respect. Any abuse of players, staff or equipment may result in forfeiture and/or suspension.
- 8. Forfeits: if you are unable to make a match please contact the office before 5pm on game day so the coordinator and your opponent may be notified.
- 9. Subs allowed during the regular season. At least one person from your team must be present for a match to be official. Should a team only have 1 player, they must skip every other turn (where the missing player would be shooting).
- 10. Two or more unannounced forfeits during the season may result in suspension from the league or playoffs.
- 11. Playoffs are double elimination and will be seeded according to: 1) record 2) head to head (2 tied teams) 3) least games against 4) most games won 5) coin flip
