

# Multi-Factor Authentication: Set up a Second Authentication Method

- Please follow the steps below for setting up.





## Sign in to your Account to view available authentication methods

Go to [login.georgefox.edu](http://login.georgefox.edu), enter your GFU credentials and sign into your account.

# Multi-Factor Authentication: Set up a Second Authentication Method

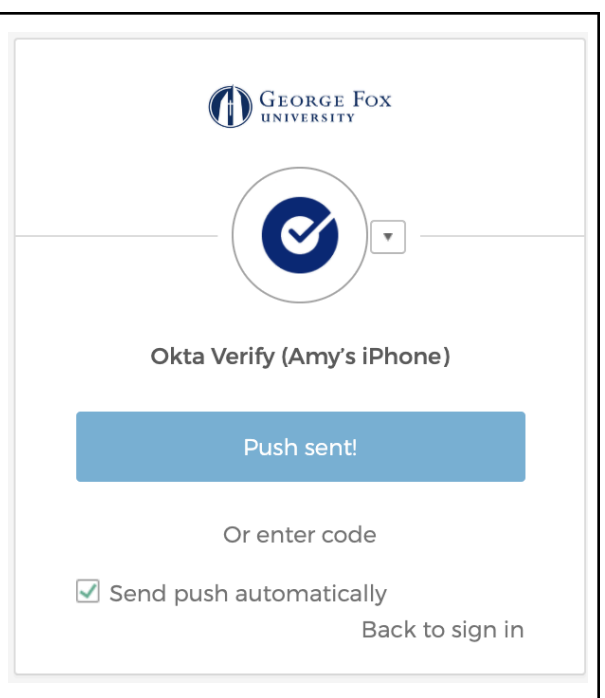


<p>You may be asked for your authentication method you have currently set up.</p> <p>You can toggle between the methods you have set up by clicking 'Verify with something else'.</p>	
<p>After signing in, click on your name in the upper right hand corner.</p> <p>Choose Settings in the drop down menu.</p>	
<p>In Settings, click the green "Edit Profile" button near your name.</p>	
<p>Verify your password.</p>	

# Multi-Factor Authentication: Set up a Second Authentication Method



You will be asked to use your current Multi-factor authentication method to finish verification.

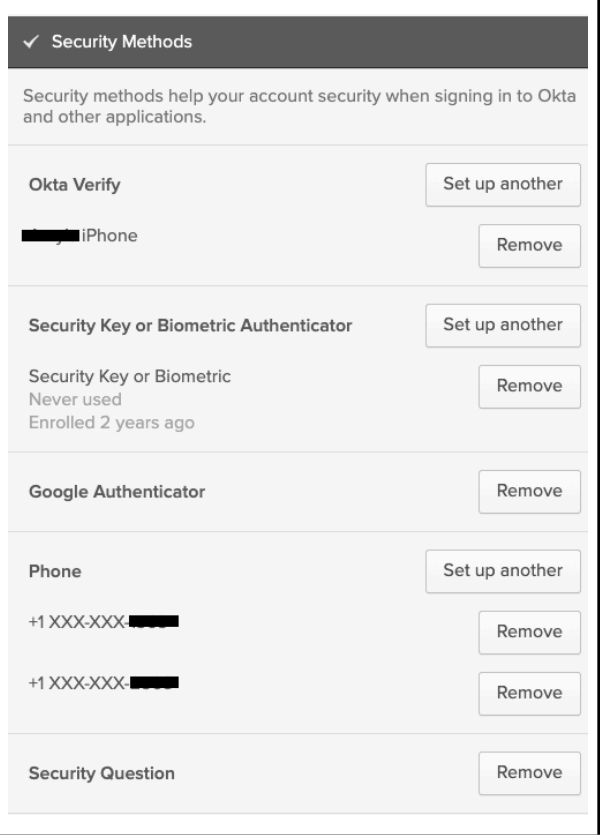


Scroll down to Security Methods.

\*We do not recommend the biometric method - it can be inconsistent and device specific.

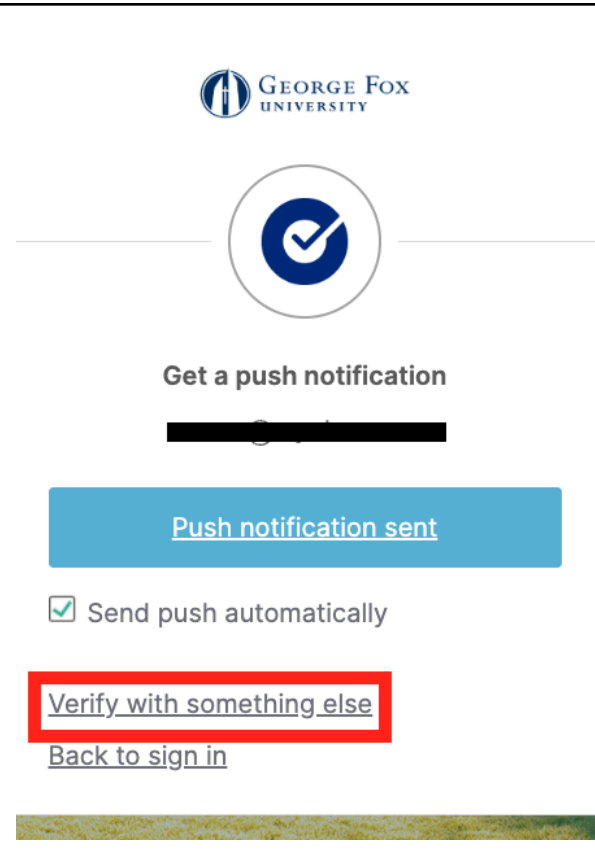
