Aim(s) of the Course	The main aim of this course is to equip students with the ability to communicate in daily spoken Turkish and to support their basic language needs during their stay in Turkey.
Learning Outcomes of the Course	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand and respond to simple spoken phrases related to their personal and daily life. • Introduce themselves and others using basic sentence structures. • Communicate in routine tasks such as shopping and using public transport. • Describe their family, hobbies, and basic personal information using simple expressions. • Ask and answer short, formulaic questions in familiar contexts.
Course Content	Students will reach approximately half of A1 level in spoken and listening skills according to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR). Basic vocabulary, expressions, and sentence structures are practiced in real-life contexts such as introducing oneself, shopping, transportation, and daily routines.
