

CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE

CA4400608-FOREST SPRINGS 08/20/2025

A precautionary boil water notice was issued to all Forest Springs customers in Boulder Creek beginning on July 31, 2025, due to planned full and partial water shut offs related to meter installation work and to address extreme excessive water use by certain residents, which was possible because there were no meters in place previously. The State Water Resources Control Board – Division of Drinking Water, the Santa Cruz County Health Department, and the Forest Springs Improvement and Maintenance Association advised residents to only use boiled tap water or bottled water for drinking and cooking as a safety precaution to avoid stomach or intestinal illness.

During the planned shutoffs, crews completed installation of the Fourth Acorn Line's water meter and protective Christy boxes, prepared corrections for meter placements on Acorn 1–3 and Leafwood lines, and confirmed wiring and data upload from the new metering system. These upgrades have significantly improved our ability to monitor the system and target leak detection efforts moving forward.

The [Forest Springs](#) Water System in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board, has determined that, through abatement of the health hazard and comprehensive testing of the water, your water is safe to drink. **It is no longer necessary to boil your tap water or for you to consume bottled water.**
