



"AI Trivia Time" Privacy Policy/Privacy Notice



Last Updated: September 8, 2026

AI Trivia Time is an educational, classroom-based AI literacy experience designed for **educators** to use with students. Day of AI is committed to protecting the privacy of students and educators and to minimizing the personal information collected through the experience.

AI Trivia Time is designed so that students can participate without creating an account, providing their name or email address, or submitting personal information to Day of AI.

This Privacy Notice explains what information we collect, how we use and protect it, and the privacy practices that apply when AI Trivia Time is used in schools and other educational settings.

1. Student Privacy by Design

AI Trivia Time is designed as an educator-facilitated classroom experience.

Students are not required to:

- Create an account
- Provide a name or email address
- Upload photos, videos, or audio recordings
- Submit written free-response answers
- Provide demographic information
- Provide precise location information

AI Trivia Time is not designed to create individual student profiles or track individual student performance.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect limited information from educators who access, register for, or facilitate AI Trivia Time, such as:

- Educator name
- Educator email address
- School or organization name, if provided
- Grade band or subject area

We may also collect limited technical and usage information necessary to operate, secure, understand, and improve the experience. Depending on how the platform is accessed and configured, this may include information such as:

- Browser or device type
- General geographic region
- Classroom or session activity
- Question completion counts
- Grade-band participation
- Technical logs necessary for security, troubleshooting, and platform operation

Where possible, usage information is aggregated or de-identified.



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We do not use technical information to create profiles of individual students.

3. Information We Do Not Ask Students to Provide

AI Trivia Time does not ask students to provide:

- Student names
- Student email addresses
- Student account credentials
- Student photos, videos, or audio recordings
- Student free-response text
- Precise geolocation
- Grades or academic records
- Demographic profiles
- Individual assessment records

AI Trivia Time does not generate student grades or individual student analytics.

4. How We Use Information

Information collected through AI Trivia Time may be used to:

- Provide and operate the classroom experience
- Facilitate educator participation
- Maintain the security and reliability of the platform
- Troubleshoot technical issues
- Understand aggregate participation and usage
- Evaluate and improve the educational experience
- Communicate with educators about AI Trivia Time or related Day of AI educational resources
- Administer classroom or educator prizes, when applicable
- Meet legal, contractual, or reporting obligations

We do not use student information for targeted advertising, behavioral profiling, or commercial marketing.

We do not sell or rent student personal information.

We do not use student data submitted through AI Trivia Time to train artificial intelligence models.

5. Service Providers and Data Sharing

We may use service providers to host, maintain, secure, analyze, or otherwise support AI Trivia Time.

Service providers may process information only as necessary to provide services on our behalf and subject to appropriate contractual, confidentiality, security, or data protection requirements.

We do not sell personal information collected through AI Trivia Time or share student personal information with third parties for targeted advertising or behavioral profiling.

Information may also be disclosed when reasonably necessary to:

- Comply with applicable law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request



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- Protect the security or integrity of AI Trivia Time
- Protect the rights, safety, or property of Day of AI, our users, or others

6. Data Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect information collected through AI Trivia Time from unauthorized access, use, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

No online service can guarantee absolute security, but we seek to minimize the amount of personal information collected and limit access to information to those who need it for legitimate operational purposes.

7. Data Retention

We retain identifiable educator information only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by applicable law.

When identifiable information is no longer reasonably necessary, we may delete or de-identify it.

Aggregate or de-identified information that does not reasonably identify an individual may be retained for program evaluation, reporting, research, and improvement.

We do not intentionally maintain individual student profiles, scores, grades, or assessment histories through AI Trivia Time.

8. Children's Privacy and School Use

AI Trivia Time is specifically designed for **educator-facilitated** educational use and minimizes the collection of information from students.

Students do not need to create accounts or provide their names, email addresses, or other directly identifying information to participate.

Depending on the location of the educator, school, or student, different privacy and student-data requirements may apply. These may include, where applicable, the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) in the United States, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and related European data protection laws, UK data protection requirements, and other national, regional, state, provincial, or local privacy requirements.

Schools and educational organizations remain responsible for determining whether their use of AI Trivia Time is consistent with requirements that apply to them.

Day of AI will work with schools and educational organizations to provide reasonable information needed for privacy or technology reviews.

9. U.S. Schools: COPPA and FERPA



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AI Trivia Time is designed so that students can participate without creating accounts or submitting personal information to Day of AI.

For U.S. schools, AI Trivia Time is designed to support school use consistent with applicable student privacy requirements, including COPPA and FERPA.

AI Trivia Time is not designed to create or maintain individual student education records, grades, scores, or student-level assessment analytics.

Nothing in this Privacy Notice changes a school's obligations under applicable federal, state, or local student privacy laws.

10. International Privacy

Privacy and data protection requirements vary by country and region.

Where applicable law provides individuals with rights regarding their personal information, those rights may include the ability to request:

- Access to personal information
- Correction of inaccurate information
- Deletion of personal information
- Restriction of certain processing
- Objection to certain processing
- Withdrawal of consent where processing is based on consent
- A copy or transfer of certain personal information

These rights may vary depending on the individual's location and applicable law.

11. International Data Processing

Day of AI operates in the United States, and information collected through AI Trivia Time may be processed or stored in the United States or other countries where Day of AI or its service providers operate.

Where required by applicable law, we use appropriate measures designed to protect personal information when it is transferred across national borders.

12. No Advertising, Profiling, or Sale of Data

AI Trivia Time is an educational experience.

participation data is not used for:

- Targeted or behavioral advertising
- Commercial profiling
- Selling or renting student information
- Building commercial student profiles



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- Training artificial intelligence models on student data

13. Not an Assessment

AI Trivia Time is a discussion-based learning experience. It is not designed or intended to evaluate, grade, measure, or track individual student performance.

AI Trivia Time does not generate student scores, grades, or student-level analytics.

Educators may use questions and discussions to support classroom learning, but AI Trivia Time itself is not a formal assessment system.

14. Accessibility and Inclusive Participation

We strive to make AI Trivia Time accessible to diverse learners and classroom environments.

Educators may adapt pacing, participation formats, discussion methods, and other instructional elements to meet the needs of their students.
