Virtual webinar series as a way to develop a CHTDWG; it would be great to coordinate through NHTDWG; as a way to recruit locally

Can generate revenue, but depends on if IOFA have the infrastructure to handle the IOFA – IOFA does have the capacity for it

Free for general members, but a price for others

We'd also need funds to cover the costs of presenters, interpreters, captioning. And, there seems to be a real desire to learn about this intersection. So I think we should do a little research to see what folks are charging but I think a starting point for the fee should be around \$200 - \$250.

Depends on targeted audience and number of days – Helpful to find sponsors

Maybe, for survivors, it would be a sliding scale?

Getting corporate sponsors --- Many mission statements are value-oriented, so maybe they can sponsor a conference but also make sure we don't need to conform to them

Conference could be: One and a half/two-year year goal



If we could find a \$50,000 grant to do this conference, maybe we can make it a no-cost event?
