Traditions and Holidays

- On July 7th everyone gives precious gifts to each other. This symbolizes God showing Reito the 7 rules to live by.

Beliefs

- Sacrians believe that as long as you follow the seven rules to live by you will be reborn until you do something great for the world and that once you do you will go up to live with god
- They also believe that if you stray from the seven rules to live by and do evil in your life then you will be reborn into a life where you will face hardship because that is your punishment for doing evil.
- Sacrians believe that if they were robes from Reito's time then they will also be able to do good in the world.
