- **YES / NO QUESTIONS** : We use **INVERSION**

groupA: to **be/modals/have+...** => just use inversion

no DO/DOES/DID

1. **to BE** **Are** you OK? **Is** he.... **Are** they....
 Was she.....
2. **MODALS** **Can** you speak English? **Must** you...
 Shouldn't you.... **Will** you.... **Would** you
 May I.....?
3. **to have+.....** **Have** you **got** a passport?
 Have you **been** on holiday yet?
 Have you **finished** yet?

groupB: (90%) => use DO/DOES/DID and inversion

Do you like sushi? NOT Like you sushi
Do you speak English?
Does she live here?
Did you go to school last week?

- **WH- QUESTIONS**: We use QUESTION PRONOUN+INVERSION

How are you? NOT How you are
Where do you live?
When did you arrive?
Who did you send it to?
Why don't you love me any more?

DIRECT / **INDIRECT !!!!!!!!!!!!!**

In job interview Q's are formal (50%)

What can you do? **DIRECT** (inversion)

Could you tell me what you can do?

INDIRECT (embedded) (QUESTION HEAD + NO INVERSION)

Could you tell me - question head

>>>>> no inversion

When will you start? **DIRECT**

Could you tell me when you will start?

INDIRECT

Where did you work before? **DIRECT**

Could you tell me where you worked

before? **INDIRECT** (DID+WORK =>WORKED)

What uni did you graduate from? **DIRECT**

Could you tell me what uni you graduated from? **INDIRECT** (DID+GRADUATE
=GRADUATED)

indirect Yes / No (+IF/WHETHER)

Can you speak English? **DIRECT**

Could you tell me **if / whether** you can
speak English? **INDIRECT** (no inversion)

Did you work before?

Can you tell me **if/whether** you worked
before? (NO INVERSION)

INDIRECT Q'S + I DON'T KNOW + TENSES REVIEW


