YEARBOOKS-Senior Portraits

Important information for seniors and parents:

Senior portraits — Upload online by Dec. 1
Senior portraits must be submitted online under the Yearbook Snap tab. Go to yearbookforever.com, search for Groves
High School and select the Groves link to continue. Click on the Yearbook Snap image.

From the Yearbook Snap page:

- Enter groves as the access code and select Enter.
- Click on Upload Photo and select a photo to upload from your computer or device. Make sure your file is 300 dpi.
- Once it uploads, select Portraits from the drop-down menu.
- Fill in your student's formal name and click Submit Photos.

IMPORTANT:

- You must work out with your photographer when you need to be photographed to be able to make the Dec. 1
- · If you use a photographer other than Prestige, the only way to guarantee that your portrait makes it in the yearbook is to personally check with Erica Neumayr before the deadline.
- You or your photographer must upload your portrait by the due date. This is not the date of your photo shoot. It is the date by which Erica Neumayr needs the photo.

- Use the portrait above as a guide for sizing, attire and guality.
- Approx 2x3 in., color retouched photographs, head and shoulders, both eyes showing
- Distance from top of head to chin is 1.25 in.
- Medium blue/gray/brown background
- No hands or props showing
- Soft focus is accepted
- No shoulders showing or low-cut tops

*Be aware that portraits not meeting these guidelines will not be accepted.

Class composite: (Read carefully)

The class composite is a picture of the senior class that is displayed in the school and handed out to seniors who are included in the picture. Our composite is made by Prestige, if you do not go through Prestige for your senior formal photo, it will not be included

Senior Exam Exemption Policy (effective Feb. 2025)

A Senior can be exempt from taking a Final Exam in a class if they meet the following criteria. These rules are applied on a class-by-class basis:

- 1. The senior must not be taking the course on a Pass/Fail basis.
- 2. The senior must be receiving a grade of 3.0 or above for the term.
- 3. The senior must not have more than 8 absences for the Semester, excluding specific school-sponsored events.
- 4. Any senior who has accumulated 6 tardies in the second semester must take the final examinations.

Commencement Ceremony Information



General Information:

- Commencement will be held on Sunday, June 7th at **MEADOWBROOK AMPHITHEATER** Commencement will begin promptly at 10:00 am.
- Graduates should report to the staging area no later than 9:00am. to check in for the ceremony and begin the process of lining up. Parents and guests will not be permitted in the staging area prior to graduation.
- Special parking and seating for disabled guests are available. Please contact Groves High School-Tracey Flaherty at 248-203-3500 for information.
- We will review commencement procedures with the seniors during graduation rehearsal on June 5th. Students will also have information regarding their seat assignment provided on June 5th so you are able to plan where you will sit at Meadowbrook. Please don't save seats.
- The Groves High School Commencement is a formal ceremony. Because the ceremony involves over 300 students, certain standards have been established to ensure that all of the graduates' names are heard clearly as all students have work to earn the privilege to graduate. Guests are reminded that out of respect for all of our graduates, anything that detracts from the dignity of the ceremony will not be permitted, including noisemakers and air horns.
- <u>Students who do NOT wish to participate in the graduation ceremony will need to notify Mr. Peterson (opeterson@birmingham.k12.mi.us)</u> in writing by May 23.



Required Attire for Graduates:

GROVES HIGH SCHOOL BEVERLY HILLS, MI | Jostens

All students (regardless of gender) will wear a Groves green gown and will line up alphabetically for the ceremony. ***No student is to decorate his/her cap before the ceremony. If a student decorates any part of the gown or cap, they will be provided another one to wear for the ceremony.

As we prepare for graduation, we want to ensure a respectful and unified ceremony. Please review the following guidelines regarding graduation attire:

Honor Cords & Stoles:

- All honor cord colors must be pre-approved by Mr. Henshaw and must represent a school-sponsored activity or club. Cords from outside organizations or non-affiliated clubs are not permitted.
- **Graduation stoles** must also be pre-approved by the Groves administration and may only represent school-sponsored activities or organizations.
- Personalized stoles and non-school-affiliated stoles are not allowed at graduation.

Caps & Gowns:

- Students are not allowed to decorate their graduation cap in any way. If a student decorates any part of the graduation cap, they will be provided another one to wear for the ceremony.
- Graduation gowns must not be altered or decorated. Students must wear the gown provided by the school's approved vendor as received. All students (regardless of gender) will wear a Groves green gown and will line-up alphabetically for the ceremony.
- **Any student who has not ordered a cap/gown/stole should contact Jostens as soon as possible.

Students will keep their gowns, stoles, cords, tassels and their caps after the ceremony. If a student throws his/her cap during the ceremony, it is not guaranteed to be returned!

Violations of these guidelines will result in the student being asked to remove the item. In some cases, students may be required to switch to a different gown. Failure to comply may result in the student not being permitted to walk across the stage during graduation.

Participation in the graduation ceremony is a privilege, not a right. It is essential that all students comply with these rules and regulations to maintain the integrity of this special event.

Thank you for your support in upholding these expectations. If you have any questions, please contact the school administration.

 It is strongly recommended that graduates <u>not</u> bring purses, bags, or any other items to the ceremony unless they have a family member who can hold them. Graduates will not be allowed to carry anything into the graduation ceremony. Cell phones will need to be silenced during the ceremony.




Photograph Information
