The Broadband Board Received a new quote for Catastrophic Insurance from PURMA that covers unexpected damage to the system including, but not limited to 'Terrorism'. The new quote was for one year of coverage at a premium of \$3091.00. This would allow the town of Somerville

to have up to \$500,000.00 of coverage per incident with a \$1000.00 deductible.

Doug Shartzer Made a motion that the Somerville Municipal Broadband Board recommend that the Town of Somerville Selectboard Members to adopt and pay the yearly premium through PURMA for one year of Catastrophic Insurance to protect the fiber optic infrastructure for the year 2025 at a cost of \$3091.00 per year with a binding start date of April 1 2025.
