## Assessment Information\*\*

**\*In order to receive SUNY credit, you must earn at least a C grade for the yearly course grade.**

**\*\*It should be noted that the details of this document may change due to unforeseen circumstances.**

### I. Quarterly Grading Criteria

- a. Summative assessments such as exams, quizzes, projects: 80%
- b. Formative assessments such as homework, classwork: 20%

### II. Works

- a. Missed Work: Any work assigned while you were legally absent from class. You have as many days as you were out to complete this work without penalty.
- b. Make-up Work: Any work assigned while you were in class or illegally absent that you did not do. If completed correctly and completely within one week, then you will receive at most half credit.
- c. Corrected Work: Any quiz that you completely correct with me during collaborative period within 1 week of the quiz being returned will earn you back at most  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the points lost. This option only exists for the first ten weeks.
