

CALAMBAGONG BUHAYANI FESTIVAL

SAYAW INDAK STREET DANCE COMPETITION 2025

GENERAL RULES

1. The contest is open to all schools (secondary & college), barangays and organizations in CALAMBA CITY.
2. Dance theme should be based on the colorful culture and rich history of Calamba and must adhere with this year's theme (*to be announced*).
3. It is encouraged to use recyclable and/or biodegradable props/materials abundant in Calamba and must feature its scenic beauty.
4. Only handheld props are allowed with a maximum size of 8 feet height and 6 ft. width. Risers to be used during the competition will be provided by the organizers.
5. No harmful stunts and props (like sharp objects, flammable materials, etc.) is allowed.
6. The group must have a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 70 members (this includes nondancers crew and props men.)
7. Maximum of 12 contingents will be allowed to join. Should there be more than 12 registrants, elimination round will take place.
8. The sequence in the order of parade and dance showdown shall be determined by drawing of lots.
9. The competition shall be divided into two (2) parts: 70% of the score shall come from the DANCE SHOWDOWN on June 13 while 30% shall be scored during the BUHAYANI GRAND PARADE on June 19.
10. The Decision of Judges shall be final and executory.
11. Unruly behavior, unsportsmanship and disrespect to the judges and organizing committee shall be grounds for disqualification.
12. Registration Requirements: Accomplished Registration form, list of participants, short profile of the dance group (maximum of 50 words), waiver and photo copy of 2 government issued i.d.'s of coordinator in charge.
13. Deadline of submission of requirements is on April 23 and submission of list of participants is until May 23 at the Cultural Affairs, Tourism and Sports Development Department (CATSDD), City Hall of Calamba, Brgy. Real, Calamba City.

14. The criteria for judging:

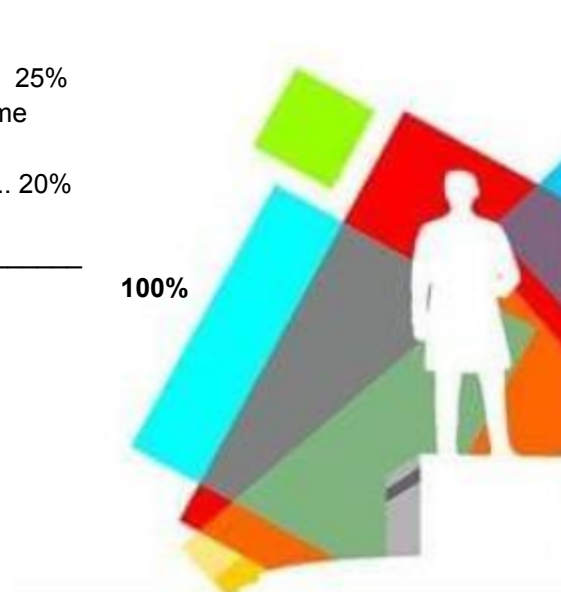

The first place winning group shall not automatically represent the city in the Anilag Festival 2026.

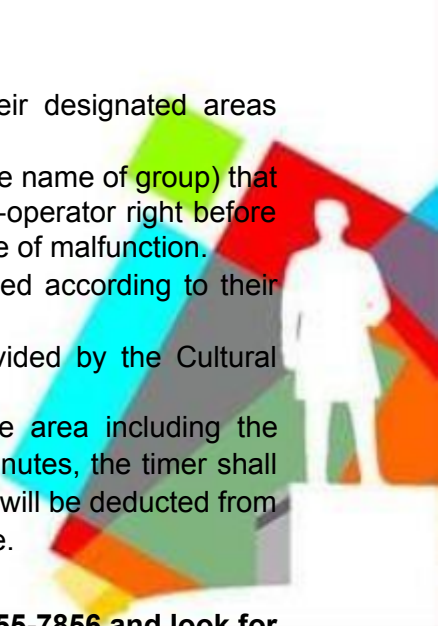
STREET DANCE COMPETITION (PARADE)-June 19

- a) All groups shall have a CHOREOGRAPHED-FORWARD MOVING STREET DANCE at SM Footbridge in Crossing area and a ONE MINUTE SPOT PERFORMANCE (STATION) in front of Museo ni Jose Rizal during the parade, using the Buhayani theme song.
- b) All Street dance participants shall assemble at the Entrance of CMC not later than 1:00 pm, in their complete costume attire.
- c) Each group must assign two of their members to carry a banner or streamer (to be provided by the organizers) bearing the name of the school they are representing.
- d) The organizers will have an assigned FIRST AID TEAM in designated areas, however, each group must have their own support staff to carry out first aid in case of emergency and to provide necessities of the group such as water, food, etc.

DANCE SHOWDOWN (JOSE RIZAL PLAZA)-June 13

- a) All street dancing participants shall assemble at 1:30 PM in their designated areas outside of the dance area (venue to be announced).
- b) Each group shall provide a flash drive (properly labeled indicating the name of group) that contains ONLY the music material and must be given to the audio-operator right before the performance. It is advised that they bring extra flash drive in case of malfunction.
- c) The props to be used by the participating groups shall be arranged according to their number in the program.
- d.) The music to be used is the Buhayani Theme Song, to be provided by the Cultural Affairs, Tourism and Sports Development Department.
- e.) Each group shall be given a total of 12 minutes in the dance area including the preparations and set-up and entrance/exit. At the end of the 12 minutes, the timer shall raise a red flag signifying that time limit has been reached. 2 points will be deducted from the total score for every (30) seconds in excess of the allowable time.

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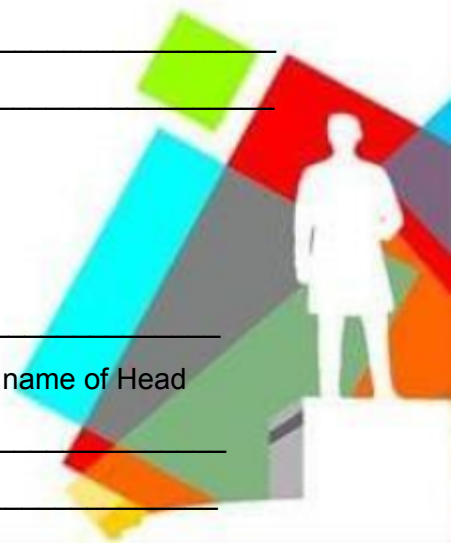

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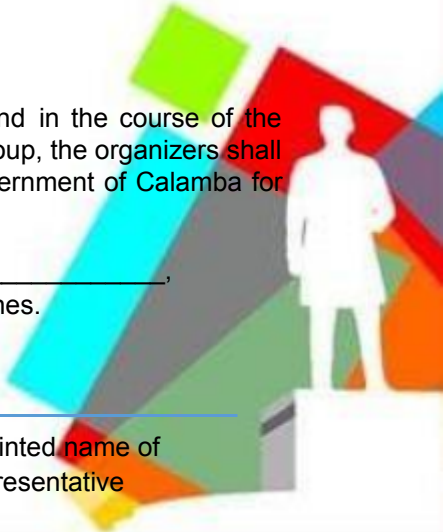
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
