# **Key Word in 2 Timothy**

## Faith

- 1. 2Tim 1:5 (NIV) I have been reminded of your sincere **faith**, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also.
- 2. 2Tim 1:13 What you heard from me, keep as the pattern of sound teaching, with **faith** and love in Christ Jesus.
- 3. 2Tim 2:18 who have wandered away from the truth. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they destroy the **faith** of some.

#### Word

#### **Endured**

- 1. 2Tim 2:3 (NIV) **Endure** hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus.
- 2. 2Tim 2:10 Therefore I **endure** everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.
- 3. 2Tim 2:12 if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us;
- 4. 2Tim 4:5 But you, keep your head in all situations, **endure** hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.

# **SUFFER** (suffering, persecutions, chains)

#### TRUTH

- 2Tim 2:18 who have wandered away from the truth. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they destroy the faith of some.
- 3. 2Tim 2:25 Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the **truth**,

#### **GRACE**

#### **TEACH** (teaching, instruction, doctrine)

- 1. 2Tim 1:13 (NIV) What you heard from me, keep as the pattern of sound **teaching**, with faith and love in Christ Jesus.
- 2. 2Tim 2:17 Their teaching will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus,
- 3. 2Tim 3:10 You, however, know all about my **teaching**, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance.
- 4. 2Tim 3:16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for **teaching**, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,
- 5. 2Tim 2:2 (NIV) And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to **teach** others.
- 6. 2Tim 2:24 And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to

teach, not resentful.

- 7. 2Tim 4:2 (NIV) Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful **instruction**.

#### LOVE

#### **POWER**

- 1. 2Tim 1:7 (NIV) For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of **power**, of love and of self-discipline.
- 8 So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord, or ashamed of me his prisoner. But join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the **power** of God,
- 3. 2Tim 3:5 having a form of godliness but denying its **power**. Have nothing to do with them.

## LIFE

- 1. 2Tim 1:1 (NIV) Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, according to the promise of **life** that is in Christ Jesus,
- 2Tim 1:9 who has saved us and called us to a holy life--not because of anything we have done
  but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the
