1. **Open Keynote:**

Open the Keynote app on your device.

2. **Start a New Project:**

Tap the plus sign (+) in the top right-hand corner to start a new project.

3. **Choose a Theme:**

Select a theme for your presentation. For this kaleidoscope effect, choose a simple theme like "White" or any other that suits your preference.

4. **Delete Text and Create a Blank Canvas:**

Delete any existing text on the slides to create a blank canvas for your kaleidoscope.

5. **Customize Background Color:**

Tap on the paintbrush icon to access the formatting options. Change the color of the background to your liking.

6. **Access Shapes:**

Tap on the shapes icon (a circle and square) to access the shapes menu.

7. **Choose Basic Shapes:**

Once satisfied with your design, tap on one of the shapes, select "Select Objects," choose "Select All," and tap "Done." Then, group the selected shapes.

11. **Animate the Grouped Shape:**

Tap on the grouped shape, select "Animate," and choose "Add Action" from the animation options.

12. **Choose Rotation Animation:**

Select "Rotate" as the animation type. Adjust the rotation duration (e.g., 20-30 seconds), direction (clockwise or counterclockwise), and number of rotations (at least 10).

13. **Adjust Animation Start Time:** Change the animation start option from "On Tap" to "After Transition."

14. **Copy and Paste:**

Copy the animated shape and paste it multiple times to create a pattern. Arrange the copies to form your kaleidoscope design.

15. **Synchronize Animations:**

To ensure all shapes rotate together, change the start time of each shape's animation to "With Build One."

16. **Preview:**

Hit the play button to preview your kaleidoscope effect.

17. **Export as Movie:**

Once satisfied, export your slide as a movie. Save it to your camera reel or any desired location.

18. **Share:**

Share your kaleidoscope masterpiece with others or use it in your projects.
