

1. Open Minecraft and go to Lesson Library -> Starter Worlds -> Build Plates -> Blocks of Grass.

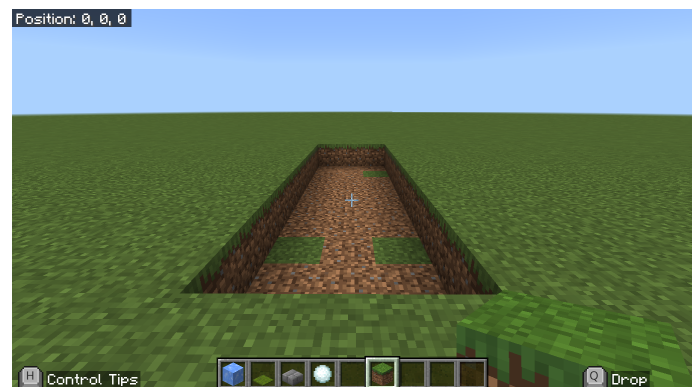
This is a nice wide open space to give this project a try!



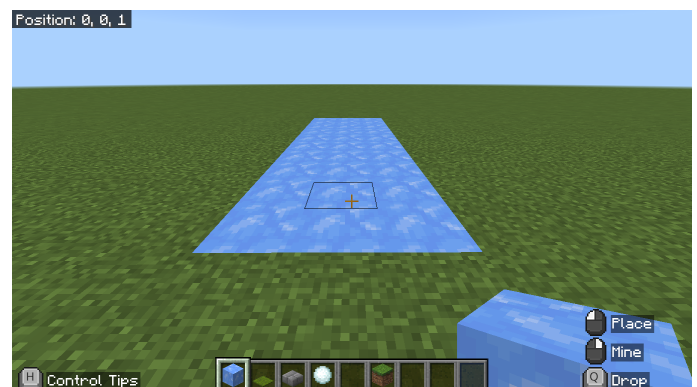
2. To start your mini golf course, you will need to gather the following items.



3. Dig a trench that measures 3 blocks wide by 10 blocks long, by 1 block deep.



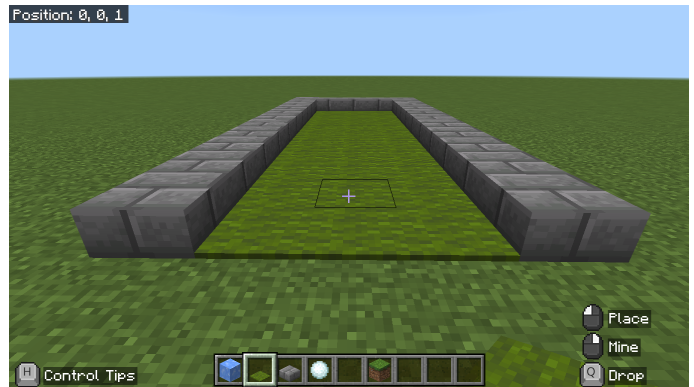
4. Fill the trench with Blue Ice.



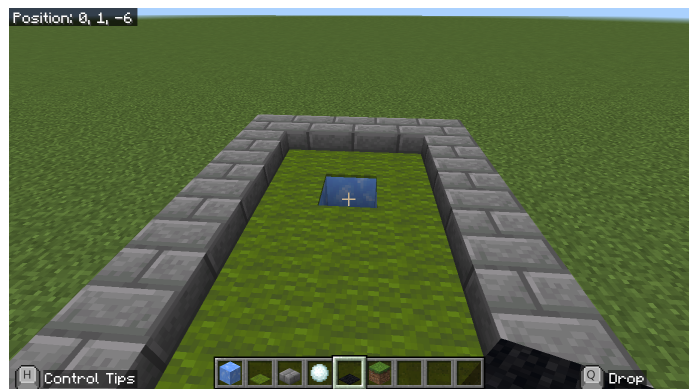
5. Use the slab to line three sides of the ice-filled trench. This makes the walls of your golf hole.



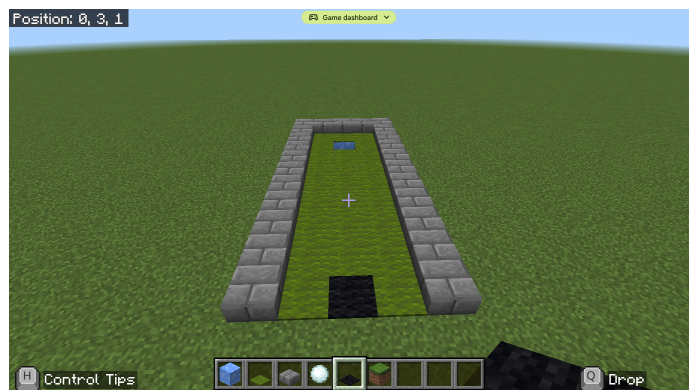
6. Cover the ice with the carpet. It's starting to look like a mini-golf hole, isn't it?



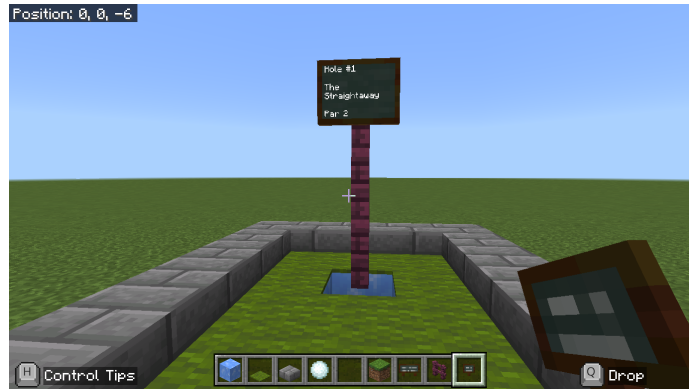
7. Go to the far end of the hole and dig out the actual hole, known as the cup.



8. **OPTIONAL:** Place a square of black carpet down to show the player where to start.



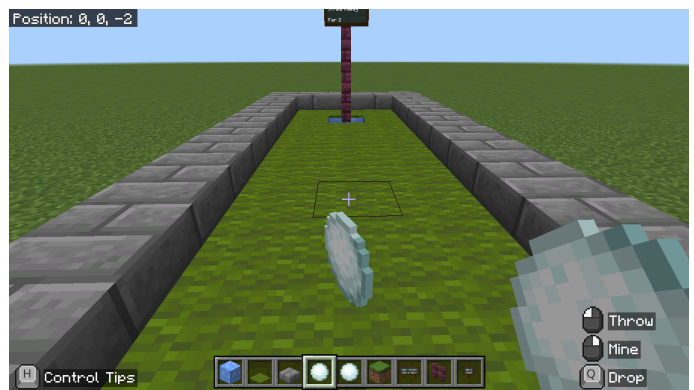
9. OPTIONAL: Use fencing to build the flagstick, then attach a slate to make the flag pole, with information about the hole.



10. Time to test it out! Select the snowball. Don't throw it, the snowball will just break. Press the button to Drop it. For me, it's the Q button on the keyboard.



11. So take aim, and make your shot!



12. Walk up to the spot where the ball stopped, then take your next shot!





13. This is a super basic mini-golf hole. Think about additional features like obstacles, different levels, and more. Search YouTube for more ideas!
