

Inspiration Guitar

Overview: The *Inspiration Guitar* features a challenge coin and signed "JEDI" flight patch flown in Earth's Orbit by Dr. Proctor during the Inspiration4 Mission. The challenge coin is spin-mounted in a Dragon capsule-shaped headstock. Additionally, a signed Inspiration4 patch and a "ground control-styled" detachable microphone are included. The back features a "landing gear" kickstand. LED lights evoke the Earth-glow witnessed by Dr. Proctor on her historic flight. Machined Aluminum accents tie together spacecraft theme.

Guitar details: We used DiMarzio F-spaced PAF humbuckers sealed with Cesar Diaz wax and soldered to raw German silver alloy covers. Engine-turned aluminum accents further shield wiring and controls. A Warmoth 1956 large V boatneck neck with 22 wide jumbo #1600 frets, compound 10 - 16" radius is joined to the XGP paulownia wood telecaster-style body via machine threaded neck bolt inserts. Finished in black nitro lacquer and 3 clear coats. Three output choices are included: XLR for microphone, one 1/4" output for guitar, and a second 1/4" output for a blended microphone/guitar-pickup output with a hardwired tone circuit to prevent feedback. Three-way pickup selector and mic bypass modify tone, and most importantly, the volume dial goes to 50, which is 39 greater than Spinal Tap's!
